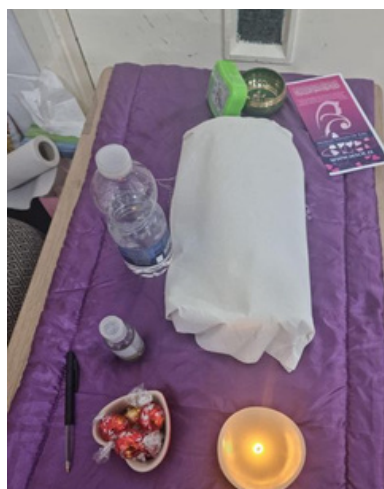

Female Health

Many thanks to AkiDWA for the invitation to promote our Period poverty initiative in February. It was a very successful and wonderful opportunity to network with our peers on issues related to health and needs for our community. We discussed the social determinants of health, including gender-based violence and cancer. We had an excellent opportunity to meet some of the women in the direct provision centres.



Sadly these women were using the products that we displayed which were socks, rags and dish cloths.

We would like to thank Women's Aid and Period Poverty Ireland for donating sanitary pads.

We also had the opportunity to meet Minister Ivana Catherine Bacik who has been Leader of the Labour Party to discuss period poverty, specifically in direct provision.

Many people would think this only happens in developing countries and not in Ireland. We receive many requests to attend provision centres to educate women about female health and menstrual hygiene. Many of the girls do not have products and are unaware of where to dispose of them, as there are no facilities to dispose safely.

Ramadan

We had several campaigns for the month of Ramadan the month of giving.

- We helped out families in need by distributing food hampers.
- We collaborated with the Muslim Girls of Éire to support fasting brothers in hostels on a weekly basis throughout Ramadan. We distributed bags with non-perishable food items, Quran and a prayer mat to 40 brothers in difficult situations, in collaboration with the MGOE. The kitchens in these hostels close early and they don't have the resources to arrange suhoor, which leaves these brothers in a difficult situation during Ramadan.
- We also had an Eid Toy Drive for children in direct provision in collaboration with the Muslim Girls of Éire. Toys for children aged 1 to 14 years were delivered on Eid as a treat for these families.
- We had our Launchgood campaign during the entire month of Ramadan where people donated money every day, we raised €13,300 to feed the homeless.
- In addition we also hosted an Interfaith Iftar as well as an Iftar dinner for Reverts.
- We had a fantastic Eid Party with many families coming together to celebrate this joyous occasion.





Soup Run

Our soup run continues to run outside the GPO every Friday with the generous support from Safco Fine Foods, Golden Olive, Dante Pizza, Dabar Restaurant, Brazzerie, donations from the public and our Volunteers!
